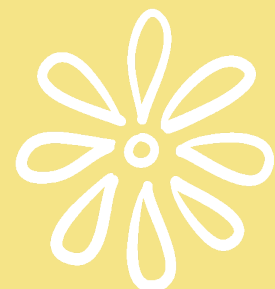

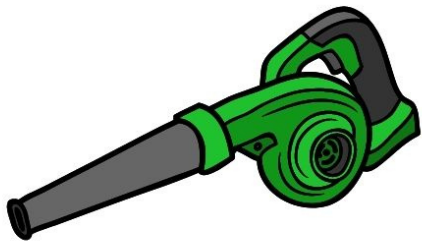

Mowing Season is Here



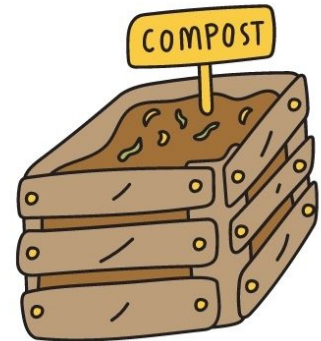
Grass clippings and yard waste should **never** be left in the street, or blown into the gutters/storm drains. It is dangerous for motorists and if storm drains get clogged it can cause flooding.



Blow the yard waste back into your yard



Sweep/rake and bag yard waste



Add it to the compost bin or leave it in the yard as a natural fertilizer

In residential areas grass, weeds and brush are not to exceed six inches in height

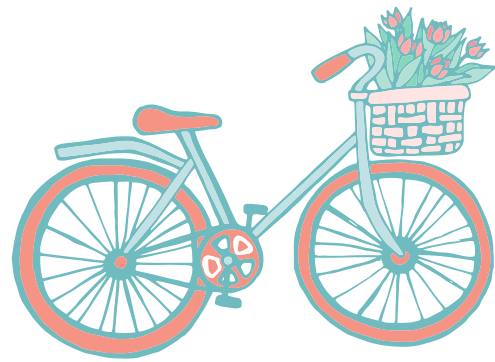

Ironman North American Championship is going through Cumming. On June 12th make sure to give yourself extra time to get to your destination. Cumming Avenue will be one lane. Warren County will be handling traffic control.



Waste Connections will be picking up yard waste every other week (opposite of recycling pickup.) For them to pick up, put yard waste into a brown paper bag and attach a yardwaste sticker, available to buy for \$1.50 at City Hall or through Waste Connections.

Branches can be bagged the same way or bundled as shown.

The following are the guidelines from Waste Connections of Iowa website:

Acceptable Yard Waste (Bagged)

- Grass Clippings
- Leaves
- Weeds
- Soft Plant Material

All items must be bagged with a Waste Connections Yard Waste Tag attached. They cannot weigh more than 60 pounds.
