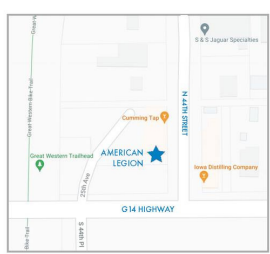

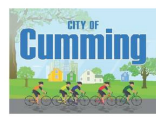

Cumming Hometown Pride has partnered with local artist Hilde DeBruyne to design a series of metal pole “banners” – 2’x4’ metal art pieces that will be attached to utility poles on the streets in Cumming. These banners will help beautify Cumming and build our community character!
