



2026 SPRING CLEAN UP

Simple Spring Cleanup Rules

Garbage Limit:

You can set out as much as will fit into the bed of one pickup truck. * if more than one truckload is set out, the entire pile will be left for the property owner to dispose of.

Weight Limit:

If it's reasonable that two people could lift the item, then it's accepted.

What items ARE accepted?

Household items that **don't** fit into your cart, such as:

- Carpet (*small rolls- 3ft in length and 18" in diameter*)
- Couches and End Tables
- Fans and Lamps
- Glass – **as long as it is broken up, placed in box, seal box & label box glass – we will NOT collect any item with glass still intact.**
- Grills (with propane removed) **If it has a press start button – remove igniter cap and remove battery.**
- Mattresses (*if there are bed bugs, the mattresses MUST be in bed bug bags*)
- TVs/Monitors
- **Appliances**
 - Air conditioners
 - Dehumidifiers
 - Dishwashers
 - Dryers
 - Freezers
 - Furnaces
 - Microwaves
 - Refrigerators
 - Stoves
 - Washers
 - Water heater

Banned substances such as:

- Lead
- Acid
- Batteries
- Waste Oil
- Explosive material
- Medical waste
- Drugs
- Paint
- Poisons
- Highly combustible materials
- Any other toxic or hazardous substance

Animal Carcasses

Asphalt shingles

Loose Trash

Concrete Chunks (ALL SIZES)

Construction & Demolition Waste

Home Improvement or landscaping items

Propane tanks

Tires

Vehicles and/or major auto parts

Wooden playsets, fencing

Please note: If items are not hauled away by the spring cleanup crew because they are unacceptable, or if they are not at the curb by 6:00am the day of pickup, it is the resident's responsibility to properly dispose of these items using normal solid waste guidelines. This also applies to unfortunate incidences of items being dropped off by others.

Residents are responsible for all items on their property.
